## **Description of Advisory:**

Microsoft's Windows 11 operating system requires a Trusted Platform Module (TPM) for installation. ZX servers without a TPM do not meet this requirement, and as such, are not compatible with Windows 11 in their current configuration.

#### **Customer Impact:**

If you are operating ZX servers that do not have TPM functionality and are considering transitioning to Windows 11, the lack of TPM will prevent successful installation and operation of the OS. This limitation stems directly from Microsoft's specifications and is not related to the hardware capabilities of ZX servers themselves.
